# HEALTH & SAFETY: COVID-19 BEST INDUSTRY PRACTICE

## THE BASICS

- Self-monitor for signs or symptoms of COVID-19 and report to administration if you are feeling ill
- Do not attend set if you are feeling ill, have had a fever in the past 14 days or come in contact with anyone that has been sick
- Wash your hands frequently and avoid touching your face as often as possible
- Limit contact with other people and keep a distance of 2 meters
- We encourage you to bring your own mask and/or gloves to wear on set at all times.
- The studio will have extra disposable masks on hand if you do not have your own
- Make sure your PPE is properly worn, regularly inspected, maintained and replaced as necessary

## OUR SPACES

- Keeping number of people on set to a minimum with essential crew only
- Monitoring and maintaining provincial guidelines as they evolve
- All crew wearing masks, with gloves when appropriate / available
- Provide masks & gloves for anyone who requires them on arrival
- Hand sanitizer on arrival and available in different areas around the studio
- Sanitizer and cleaning supplies for individuals to clean washrooms after each use
- Workplace cleaned thoroughly and often, with special consideration to frequently touched surfaces, props, equipment, sets, and common areas
- Educate and inform all attendees on best practices and safety protocols
- Extra tables and chairs to accommodate distancing for eating and lounging
- Lunches and snacks will be individually packed (No family style)
- We encourage you to bring your own water bottle, coffee cup, cutlery, etc. – however all of these items will still be available on set
- If using the studio kitchenware, we ask that you always place items in the dishwasher vs tables or sinks
- Remote approval systems in place for screen/live image sharing with clients and agency who are off site
- Separate screen viewing station(s), distanced from the photographer monitor & capture station
- Each department will have a dedicated space to assist with as much distancing as possible
